4. Permit will be in place for the 2020 Boating Season:

St. Croix River Fishing Opener through October 31, 2020

Resident agrees to have the boat registered with the State of Minnesota, in seaworthy condition when moored on City property and to remove the boat no later than November 1, 2020.

5. This permit may not be assigned or transferred to any other person.

6. Risk of Loss: The boat owner hereby assumes all risks associated with keeping a boat on City property. The boat owner will be responsible for properly insuring and caring for the boat.

7. Limitation of Liability: The City shall have no responsibility for: loss or damage to any of Citizen's property including the Boat or any property stored by the Citizen or those claiming by, through or under Citizen, at Mooring Site, or on City premises in connection with this Permit by reason of fire, lightning, water, wind storm, tornado, hail, ice, other elements, explosion, theft, malicious mischief, vandalism, theft or otherwise: not for any loss or injury to any person or persons in or about the Mooring Site, The City premises or the Boat. Citizen agrees to indemnify and hold harmless from any claim,

including reasonable attorney's fees and costs, by anyone for loss or injury to person or property arising out of or relating to the use by the Citizen of said Mooring Site, City premises or the Boat. This release and indemnity from liability shall specifically include, but not be limited to, any loss or damage caused to Citizen or those claiming by or through Residency by any obstructions in or under the surface of the water.

8. Permit holder agrees not to violate any statute, regulation or ordinance of the City. Citizen will take care to not make any undue noise about the Mooring Site, and will stay on public street when accessing Mooring Site. The Citizen will not make any alterations, additions or improvements in or to the Mooring Site, or add, disturb or in any way change the Mooring Site or City premises without prior written consent of the City.

9. If the Citizen has not removed the Boat or other equipment or personal property on or before the end of the Boating Season, the City has the right to remove the Boat and other equipment and personal property, at the Citizen's expense. The City may charge a Boat Storage Fee to the Boat Owner. If the Boat or other equipment or personal property is not removed from the storage location by February 1 of the year following the permit, the City will give the Boat or other equipment or personal property to a charitable organization, or dispose of it.

10. The City reserves the right to enact, amend and enforce such further reasonable rules as it deems suitable and Citizen agrees to comply with such rules. The location of the Mooring Site is determined at the sole discretion of the City. The Resident acknowledges the Permit is for one boating season.
