

Forest Advisory Committee Minutes 9-8-2019

The Forest Advisory Committee has formed with 3 members: Felicia Cochran, Leslie Mackenzie and Kristen Vadheim.

Peter Foster has also volunteered and John Goodfellow is providing expert guidance on forestry issues.

The committee has met twice and discussed recommendations for the planting of the trees in the gravel bed.

Noting limiting factors (such as overhead electrical), and opportunities to replace dead and declining trees, and after consulting with city employee Jason Crotty and forester John Goodfellow, the Forest Advisory Committee is recommending that the 15 trees (5 catalpa, 10 Kentucky coffee trees) be planted before October 15 in the following locations:

- 3 Kentucky Coffee - Burris park (replace dead trees)
- 2 Kentucky Coffee – Public trail around Jackson Meadow (replace dead trees)
- 2 Kentucky Coffee – Jackson Meadow (memorial trees)
- 2 Kentucky Coffee. 1 Catalpa - Cemetery (replace dead trees)
- 4 Catalpa trees – School (two north or northwest of ice rink in nature area, one on southeast corner by playground, one along 5th Street by field in line with existing trees)
- 1 Kentucky Coffee – Jeanne Kingston’s trail just north of the new pollinator garden (replace dead tree)
